

Senior Research Associate Fellow | Frequently Asked Questions

When will applications be reviewed?

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis; the position was first posted on September 17, 2026.

When should I expect to hear back from you?

Applicants can expect to receive an update within 4 to 6 weeks of submitting their application.

What are the education and work requirements for the role?

A graduate degree in public policy, economics, statistics, public administration, or a related field—and/or an equivalent combination of experience and training—is required. Candidates should have at minimum three years of relevant, full-time post-baccalaureate work experience and/or a related graduate degree. In addition, candidates should have prior experience conducting applied research. Please review the full [Job Description](#) for detailed qualifications.

I worked as an RA while I was an undergraduate student. Does that count as part of the minimum work requirements?

No. This position required a minimum of two years of full-time post-baccalaureate work experience and/or a related graduate degree.

Can I apply again if I have applied in the past?

Yes, previous applicants can re-apply.

Where is this position based?

This position is based at the Harvard Kennedy School campus, with some hybrid work options available.

Is the Senior Research Associate Fellow role open to international candidates, or is U.S. Citizenship or Lawful Permanent Residence (LPR) required?

The Senior Research Associate Fellow role is open to international candidates and does not require U.S. Citizenship or LPR. In many cases, Harvard fellows who are not U.S. Citizens or Permanent Residents have been hired under OPT or sponsored for J-1 visas. However, sponsorship is not guaranteed.

What happens next after I apply?

We have various screening and selection stages, including a first resume and cover letter screen, then data- and work-related exercises, and at least two rounds of interviews. You will be informed about the status of your application at each stage of the process.

Can I apply if I'm currently enrolled in an academic program, or are there part-time/summer internship opportunities available?

This is a full-time position that requires a full-time commitment. Unfortunately, we are not recruiting for part-time roles, internships, or summer fellowships at this time. If you're currently enrolled in a master's or PhD program with an expected completion date in or before June 2027, you are eligible to apply for this position. If you're currently enrolled in an undergraduate, master's, or PhD program with an expected completion date after June 2027, we encourage you to follow us on [LinkedIn](#) or [BlueSky](#) and subscribe to our [Newsletter](#) to stay updated on future opportunities.

Can I speak to someone at TPL to learn more about this opportunity?

To ensure a fair and unbiased recruitment process, we do not hold one-on-one conversations during an open application cycle. You should also not expect a response if you've emailed a member of the team or Professor Linos. However, candidates will have opportunities to ask questions during the interview process.
